Measure Description:

Prohibits Residential Facilities Ombudsman, designee of ombudsman or staff of ombudsman from being compelled to testify or produce documents related to complaint in any judicial or administrative proceeding.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Department of Justice (DOJ), Counties, District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Long Term Care Ombudsman (LTCO), Department of Human Services (DHS), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC)

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
