Measure Description:

Directs Oregon Health Authority to study issues related to fitness to proceed and to provide results of study to Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2021.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care to the Senate Committee on Rules.

The measure directs the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to study ways to reduce the number of persons committed to the custody of a superintendent of a state mental hospital after being determined to lack fitness to proceed. The results of the study are to be reported to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2021.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on OHA.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Rules.
