BACKGROUND:

Curtis Frederick "Curt" Benefiel was born on May 28, 1926 in Forest Grove, Oregon and met his wife, in Willamina. He served his country with honor and distinction in the United States Navy, graduated from Linfield College, and began a career in education. He enjoyed traveling and teaching in new places, including Guam and rural districts across the state of Oregon. He was an exemplary teacher, coach, bus driver, counselor, principal and superintendent, and a role model for thousands of students. He liked the University of Oregon Ducks athletics, playing dominoes and pool, hunting and fishing.

Mr. Benefiel died on June 16, 2015 at his home, surrounded by loved ones, in Stayton, Oregon.
