Measure Description:

Prohibits the Oregon Department of Justice from charging officers and agencies of state government for legal assistance rendered. Becomes operative on July 1, 2023.

Revenue Impact:

This bill has a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. Further analysis will be done when the bill reaches the committee.

Impact Explanation:

Beginning on July 1, 2023, the Oregon Department of Justice (DOJ) will be prohibited from charging state government for the cost of providing legal assistance. This may lead to a loss of Other Funds revenue from state and federal sources, to be received by DOJ. Further analysis will require additional data and information.
