**Measure Description:**

Provides that person commits offense of driving while under influence of intoxicants if person has blood alcohol level of 0.08 percent or more by weight within two hours after driving vehicle.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC), Oregon State Police (OSP), Department of Justice (DOJ), Criminal Justice Commission (CJC)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
