Directs Department of Education to coordinate with Oregon career and technical student organizations in support of organizations for purposes of increasing student achievement and leadership and improving graduation rates, college preparation and career placement for students enrolled in career and technical student organization courses.

**Analysis:** This measure directs the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to establish a grant program for the purpose of allowing school districts to provide summer career and technical student organization courses. The measure also appropriates \$1.3 General Fund to Career and Technical Student Organizations and \$900,000 General Fund to ODE for the grant program. ODE anticipates managing the grant program with existing resources.

School Districts do not anticipate a fiscal impact due to this measure.
