SUMMARY

Exempts from public disclosure addresses of individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities residing in adult foster homes, residential training facilities or residential training homes, unless public interest requires disclosure in particular instance.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure, unless public interest requires disclosure in particular instance, addresses of individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities residing in adult foster homes, residential training facilities or residential training homes.

If those public records were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive addresses of individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities residing in adult foster homes, residential training facilities or residential training homes from the Department of Human Services or the Oregon Health Authority.
