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Measure Description:

Requires a person that rents a utility vehicle to a contracting agency, at the contracting agency's request, to provide records of the most recent inspection performed on the utility vehicle's traction, structure, power train, control components and related parts, detailing how the equipment is in compliance the rules, regulations, and standards of various state and federal agencies, Instructions about how to comply with recommendations from the utility vehicle's manufacturer for operating and maintaining the utility vehicle, records of all incidents in which use of the utility vehicle during previous rentals resulted in injuries or deaths because of equipment failure, and a signed affidavit in which the person attests to compliance with applicable safety standards and to performing or having performed regular inspections of the utility vehicle.
