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Measure Description:

Authorizes eligible business to deliver malt beverages, wine or cider to final consumer through use of delivery person.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC), District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC), Oregon State Police (OSP), Department of Justice (DOJ), Statewide, Counties, Cities, Task Force/Committee/Workgroup, Criminal Justice Commission (CJC), Legislative Assembly

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on General Government to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure authorizes delivery of alcoholic beverages and establishes a 14-member Task Force on the Regulation and Enforcement of Alcohol Delivery by Third-Party Ecommerce Providers.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on Oregon Liquor Control Commission, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Oregon Judicial Department, Public Defense Services Commission, Oregon State Police, Department of Justice, Statewide, Counties, Cities, Criminal Justice Commission, Legislative Assembly.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Further Analysis Required
