SUMMARY

Establishes statewide coordinated crisis services system including 9-8-8 suicide prevention and behavioral health crisis hotline. Imposes unspecified tax on consumers and retail subscribers who have telecommunications service or interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service to pay for crisis services system.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure extends the exemption from public disclosure of automatic number identifications received by public safety answering points to calls to the 9-8-8 coordinated crisis services system.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive phone numbers from which calls were made to the 9-8-8 suicide prevention and behavioral health crisis hotline.
