SUMMARY

Places limits on admissibility of facilitated dialogue and responsibility letter bank programs for youth offenders and persons temporarily assigned to youth correction facilities.

Authorizes Oregon Youth Authority to disclose certain information to victim at victim's request or when youth authority seeks information from victim to inform case plan or about potential impact of authorizing parole of youth offender.

Authorizes district attorney to provide victim, pursuant to protective order, with copy of written waiver findings and determination.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure facilitated dialogue and responsibility letter bank program communications.

If those public records were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive communications between victims, survivors, offenders and other program participants while participating in the facilitated dialogue and responsibility letter bank program.
