Measure Description:

Allows holder of off-premises sales license to sell factory-sealed containers of malt beverages that hold more than seven gallons. Resolves potential conflict with House Bill 2264, which, if passed, removes the reference to a size limit for factory-sealed malt beverage containers and authorizes the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to adopt administrative rules or take any action necessary to carry out provisions of this measure.
