Measure Description:

Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by Board of Naturopathic Medicine.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine (OBNM)

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Analysis:

ORS 291.055(1)(e) stipulates that all new state agency fees or fee increases adopted between the date of adjournment sine die of a regular session of the Legislative Assembly and the date of adjournment sine die of the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly, are rescinded upon adjournment sine die of the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly unless the fee is authorized by enabling legislation.

This measure provides the enabling legislation necessary to approve fees adopted through administrative rule by the Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine (OBNM) during the 2020-21 Interim. Fees were adjusted for license renewals and for a license change of status from inactive to active. These fee modifications are anticipated to generate \$120,000 Other Funds revenue during the 2021-23 biennium. The 2021-23 Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) Recommended Budget for OBNM assumes the continuation of the revenue from the fee increases included in this measure.
