SUMMARY

Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to develop and implement programs to make one-time payments directly to certain workers as incentive payments to return to work or as worker retention payments for workers who were frontline essential workers during first year of COVID-19 pandemic.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure information included in applications for payments from the return-to-work incentive payment program and the worker retention payment program administered by the Department of Consumer and Business Services.

If those public records were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive information contained in applications to the department for payments from the return-to-work incentive payment program and the worker retention payment program.
