SUMMARY

Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to develop and implement program to make return-to-work incentive payments to employees.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure information included in applications for payments from the return-to-work incentive payment program administered by the Department of Consumer and Business Services.

If those public records were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive information contained in applications to the department for payments from the return-to-work incentive payment program.
