House Bill 2300

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Director of Employment Department to study methods of allowing employers to pay quarterly unemployment insurance taxes over extended period. Requires director to report findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to employment on or before September 15, 2022.

Sunsets January 2, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to unemployment insurance taxes. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. The Director of the Employment Department shall conduct a study of 4 methods of allowing employers to pay quarterly unemployment insurance taxes over an ex-5 tended period. The director shall report the findings of the study in the manner provided by 6 ORS 192,245 to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to employment 7 on or before September 15, 2022. 8

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.

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
