## House Bill 2336

Sponsored by Representative MARSH, Senator GELSER (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services to establish by rule appendix in Oregon residential specialty code based upon visitability standards for Type C Units provided by American National Standards Institute.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to residential housing; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 455.
5	SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall establish b

<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall establish by rule an appendix to the Oregon residential specialty code consistent with and based upon the American National Standards Institute standards for Type C Units in section 1005 of A117.1 (2009).

(2) The appendix described under subsection (1) of this section shall be designed in a manner that facilitates adoption by local jurisdictions.

SECTION 3. (1) Section 2 of this 2021 Act becomes operative on October 31, 2021.

(2) The Department of Consumer and Business Services may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary for the department to exercise on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department by section 2 of this 2021 Act.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect on its passage.
