"SECTION 1. (1) Southern Oregon University shall develop and administer a student be-

4	enable at least 100 individuals to receive credentialing under the pilot program by June 30,
5	2023.
6	"(2) Training for the student behavioral health credentialing pilot program shall:
7	"(a) Advance the behavioral health skill level of school district staff and of individuals
8	interested in entering the workforce for student behavioral health;
9	"(b) Align with standards for the student health credentialing pilot program to ensure
10	predictability is provided for mental health care providers, school districts and other em-
11	ployers of individuals who receive training; and
12	"(c) Be coordinated and provided by:
13	"(A) Southern Oregon University;
14	"(B) The education service district that serves Jackson, Josephine and Klamath Counties;
15	and
16	"(C) Mental health care providers in Jackson, Josephine and Klamath Counties.
17	"(3)(a) The university shall establish standards by which financial assistance is made
18	available under the pilot program for the following:
19	"(A) Tuition costs and other costs incurred in relation to training and credentialing;
20	"(B) Staffing costs incurred by employers while individuals attend training; and
21	"(C) Costs incurred by providers of training.
22	"(b) When providing financial assistance under this subsection, priority shall be given to
23	enable the following to receive training and credentialing:
24	"(A) Early childhood educators;
25	"(B) Classroom assistants and other school district staff from kindergarten through
26	grade 12; and
27	"(C) Behavioral health workers interested in assisting students.
28	"(4) The university shall report on the pilot program to the interim committees of the
29	Legislative Assembly related to education no later than September 1, 2023. The report may
30	include recommendations for legislation and for methods of providing student behavioral
31	health credentialing and training throughout this state.
32	"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on December 31, 2023.
33	"SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
34	priated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for distribution to Southern
35	Oregon University, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the

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amount of \$100,000, which shall be expended for the pilot program described in section 1 of this 2021 Act.

"SECTION 4. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.".

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
