

House Bill 2418

Sponsored by Representative NERON (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires district attorney to, upon request, provide to sexual assault victim opportunity to review case file within district attorney's office.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to crime victim access to records.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Upon request, a district attorney shall provide to a sexual assault victim**
5 **the opportunity to review, within the office of the district attorney, the contents of the dis-**
6 **trict attorney's case file concerning the sexual assault.**

7 **(2) As used in this section, "sexual assault victim" means a person named as the alleged**
8 **victim in an accusatory instrument charging a crime described in ORS 163.355 to 163.427.**
