House Bill 2469

SUMMARY

Requires state medical assistance program to provide for up to six behavioral health checkups every year.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 414.766 is amended to read:
5	414.766. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 414.065 and 414.690, [a coordinated care organization must
6	provide] behavioral health services [to its members that include but are] shall be provided to re-
7	cipients of medical assistance including but not limited to all of the following:
8	[(1)] (a) For [a member] an individual who is experiencing a behavioral health crisis:
9	[(a)] (A) A behavioral health assessment; and
10	[(b)] (B) Services that are medically necessary to transition the [member] individual to a lower
11	level of care;
12	[(2)] (b) At least the minimum level of services that are medically necessary to treat $[a]$
13	member's] an individual's behavioral health condition as determined in a behavioral health assess-
14	ment of the [member] individual or specified in the [member's] individual's care plan; [and]
15	[(3)] (c) Coordinated care and case management as defined by the Department of Consumer and
16	Business Services by rule; and
17	(d) Up to six preventive behavioral health checkups every 12 months with a qualified
18	mental health provider regardless of medical necessity or whether the recipient has a be-
19	havioral health diagnosis.
20	(2) Behavioral health services described in subsection (1) of this section shall be provided
21	to all recipients of medical assistance regardless of whether they are enrolled in a coordi-

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nated care organization.
