CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to reinstating driving privileges; and prescribing an effective date.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1.** Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle Code.

**SECTION 2.** (1) In addition to the reasons for which the Department of Transportation may waive reinstatement fees under ORS 809.380 (6), the department shall waive the reinstatement fee if a driving privilege suspension occurred pursuant to any of the following or a combination of the following:

(a) ORS 809.210 (2019 Edition);

(b) ORS 809.220; or

(c) ORS 809.415 (3) for failure to provide new proof of compliance for future responsibility filings when requested by the department.

(2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to a person whose driving privileges are also concurrently suspended under provisions not listed in subsection (1) of this section.

**SECTION 3.** Section 2 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.

**SECTION 4.** This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
