CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to jurors.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 10. <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) A juror may not be identified by name in any court proceeding open to the public.

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, a court shall ensure that the names of jurors are available to the parties to a proceeding unless the court determines that there is good cause to order otherwise.
