SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Directs State Court Administrator to study methods for assigning single judge to domestic relations cases to serve throughout duration of case.]

Directs State Court Administrator to study trauma-informed procedural justice and report on results of study to appropriate committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2023.

Sunsets January 2, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to courts. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The State Court Administrator shall study ways to improve and increase trauma-informed procedural justice, identify barriers to improving and increasing trauma-informed procedural justice and recommend methods to improve delivery of trauma-informed procedural justice. The State Court Administrator shall report on the results of the study to an appropriate committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2023.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2024.
