## House Bill 2724

Sponsored by Representative WITT (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires State Department of Agriculture to establish advisory committee to advise department on policies related to Oregon crops.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to administration of the State Department of Agriculture.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Agriculture shall establish an advisory com-
5	mittee to advise the department on policies related to Oregon crops, including food and fiber
6	crops.
7	(2) The Governor or Director of Agriculture may appoint to the advisory committee from
8	seven to nine members who are leaders in an Oregon crop industry. Leaders in an Oregon
9	crop industry may nominate persons to serve as members on the advisory committee.
10	(3) The advisory committee shall:
11	(a) Meet quarterly;
12	(b) Identify policies that may impact regulatory compliance related to an Oregon crop
13	industry or change production or marketing of an Oregon crop; and
14	(c) Advise the department on policies related to Oregon crop industries.
15	(4) The advisory committee may establish policy-specific subcommittees and select for
16	service on a subcommittee persons who are members of the advisory committee.
17	(5) The department may adopt rules to carry out this section.
