SUMMARY

Prohibits government body from issuing permit for construction, expansion or modification of chemical recycling facility.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to chemical recycling.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "chemical recycling facility" means an industrial

- 5 facility that converts plastic polymers into chemical feedstocks, for use in new products or
- 6 as fuel, including any form of:
- 7 (a) Ethylene;
- 8 (b) Propylene;
- 9 (c) Polyethylene;
- 10 (d) Polypropylene;
- 11 (e) Polyvinyl chloride; or
- 12 (f) Other plastic polymer raw materials.
- 13 (2) A public body as defined in ORS 174.109 may not issue a permit or other authorization
- 14 for the construction, expansion or modification of any chemical recycling facility.
