SUMMARY

Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to [study and make recommendations regarding improvements to operations of department. Requires department to submit report on findings by January 1, 2023.] fill and utilize certain positions.

Allocates lottery moneys from Veterans' Services Fund for specified purposes. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. The Department of Veterans' Affairs shall fill and utilize the following po-
5	sitions:
6	(1) Three full-time equivalent positions for the department's function as the state ap-
7	proving agency for veterans' education and training;
8	(2) One full-time equivalent position for campus veterans programming; and
9	(3) One full-time equivalent position for the Veteran Educational Bridge Grant Program
10	established under section 1, chapter 527, Oregon Laws 2019.
11	SECTION 2. There are allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, from the
12	Veterans' Services Fund, to the Veterans' Department of Veterans' Affairs Dedicated Lot
13	tery Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:
14	(1) Veteran Educational Bridge
15	Grant Program \$ 325,000
16	(2) Campus veteran resource
17	center grant program \$ 500,000
18	(3) Department of Veterans'
19	Affairs Veteran Services
20	Grant Fund \$ 250,000
21	(4) Grants to counties for
22	veterans' courts \$ 100,000
23	SECTION 3. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
24	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect
25	July 1, 2021.
