## House Bill 2931

## **SUMMARY**

Requires person who arrests another person to ensure arrested person receives medical assessment.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 133.005 to
5	133.400.
6	SECTION 2. (1) A person who arrests another person pursuant to the authority described
7	in ORS 133.225, 133.235, 133.239 or 133.245 shall ensure that the arrested person receives a
8	medical assessment at the time of arrest or as soon as practicable after arrest.
9	(2) As used in this section, "medical assessment" means a physical examination by or
10	under the direction of a licensed physician, physician assistant or nurse practitioner.
