

House Bill 2931

Sponsored by Representative BYNUM (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires person who arrests another person to ensure arrested person receives medical assessment.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to arrested persons.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 133.005 to**
5 **133.400.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) A person who arrests another person pursuant to the authority described**
7 **in ORS 133.225, 133.235, 133.239 or 133.245 shall ensure that the arrested person receives a**
8 **medical assessment at the time of arrest or as soon as practicable after arrest.**

9 **(2) As used in this section, "medical assessment" means a physical examination by or**
10 **under the direction of a licensed physician, physician assistant or nurse practitioner.**
