House Bill 2951

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits association or other owners from retaliating or discriminating against owner for exercising owner's right. Awards attorney fees to prevailing aggrieved owner.

2	Relating to actions taken against lot owners in homeowners association.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 94.550 to 94.783.
5	SECTION 2. (1) An association, its board of directors, managers, other owners or any
6	agent acting on behalf of an association or any other owner, may not retaliate or discrimi-
7	nate against an owner because the owner, while acting lawfully and with the reasonable in-
8	tention to address, prevent or stop a violation:
9	(a) Complains of or reports an alleged violation;
10	(b) Participates in or cooperates with an investigation of a complaint or report filed;
11	(c) Otherwise acts in furtherance of a complaint, report or investigation concerning an
12	alleged violation; or
13	(d) Exercises or attempts to exercise any owner's right.
14	(2) A court shall award attorney fees to an owner who brings a claim of retaliation or
15	discrimination under this section and prevails on the claim, in addition to costs and appro-
16	priate damages or injunctive relief.
17	(3) As used in this section:
18	(a) "Owner's right" means any right of an owner arising under:
19	(A) ORS 94.550 to 94.783;
20	(B) The association's governing documents; or
21	(C) Other legally enforceable documents setting forth the rights and responsibilities of
22	the association, its board of directors or manager, or the owner.
23	(b) "Violation" means a violation of an owner's right.
