## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2964

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 22 through 30.

2	On page 2, delete lines 1 through 3 and insert:
3	"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
4	"(a) 'Community living support' includes attendant care, skills training and relief care.
5	"(b) 'Day support activities' means attendant care delivered during scheduled, structured
6	activities in a nonresidential setting that focuses on maintaining or enhancing the skills
7	needed by an individual with an intellectual or developmental disability to engage in the
8	individual's community.
9	"(c) 'Direct support professional' means an employee of a provider agency who provides
10	attendant care to individuals receiving employment services, supported living services, day
11	support activities, in-home or community living support services or services in a residential
12	training facility or residential training home.
13	"(d) 'Employment services' means individualized, evidence-based services provided to an
14	individual with an intellectual or developmental disability to assist the individual in choosing,
15	securing and retaining work in an integrated employment setting.
16	"(e) 'Medical assistance' has the meaning given that term in ORS 414.025.
17	"(f) 'Provider agency' means an entity that provides:
18	"(A) Services to individuals in residential training facilities or residential training homes;
19	"(B) In-home services;
20	"(C) Supported living services;
21	"(D) Employment services;
22	"(E) Day support activities; or
23	"(F) Community living support.
24	"(g) 'Residential training facility' and 'residential training home' have the meaning given
25	those terms in ORS 443.400.
26	"(h) 'Supported living services' means services that provide an individual with an intel-
27	lectual or developmental disability the ability to live in the community where the individual
28	wants, with whom the individual wants, for as long as the individual desires.
29	"(2) The Department of Human Services shall reimburse provider agencies for the cost
30	of care provided to medical assistance recipients in amounts sufficient to allow the provider
31	agencies to pay to their direct support professionals wages that average at least 150 percent
32	of the minimum wage established in ORS 653.025 (2) as adjusted for inflation under ORS

**653.025** (**5**).".

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
