

House Bill 2982

Sponsored by Representative HELM

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits Oregon Liquor Control Commission from disciplining licensee or licensee representative for violation if violation is result of theft.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to marijuana.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475B.010 to**
5 **475B.545.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, “appropriate,” “deprive,” “obtain” and**
7 **“property” have the meanings given those terms in ORS 164.005.**

8 **(2) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission may not impose discipline on a licensee or**
9 **licensee representative for a violation of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.545 or a rule adopted under**
10 **ORS 475B.010 to a rule adopted under ORS 475B.545 if the violation occurs because a person,**
11 **with intent to deprive the licensee or licensee representative of property, takes, appropriates,**
12 **obtains or withholds the property from the licensee or licensee representative.**

13 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2021 Act applies to violations that occur on and after the**
14 **effective date of this 2021 Act.**
