AN ACT

Relating to training of officers; amending ORS 181A.470.

## Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

**SECTION 1.** ORS 181A.470 is amended to read:

181A.470. The Board on Public Safety Standards and Training shall ensure that all police officers and certified reserve officers are trained to:

- (1) Investigate, identify and report crimes:
- (a) Motivated by prejudice based on the perceived race, color, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, **gender**, marital status, political affiliation or beliefs, membership or activity in or on behalf of a labor organization or against a labor organization, physical or mental disability, age, economic or social status or citizenship of the victim; and
  - (b) That constitute abuse, as defined in ORS 419B.005, or domestic violence.
- (2) Understand the requirements of the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations and identify situations in which the officers are required to inform a person of the person's rights under the convention.
