

House Bill 3000

Sponsored by Representative WILDE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission to study cannabis. Requires report to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary.

Sunsets January 2, 2022.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to cannabis; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall study cannabis in this state.**
5 **The commission shall report its findings and recommendations to an interim committee of**
6 **the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary no later than December 31, 2021.**

7 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2022.**

8 **SECTION 3. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**
10 **on its passage.**
