

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3011

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 4, after “repealing” insert “section 67, chapter  
2 \_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2021 (Enrolled Senate Bill 817), and”.

3 On page 3, after line 19, insert:

4 **“SECTION 7a. If Senate Bill 817 becomes law, section 67, chapter \_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2021**  
5 **(Enrolled Senate Bill 817) (amending ORS 151.225), is repealed and ORS 151.225, as amended**  
6 **by section 7 of this 2021 Act, is amended to read:**

7 “151.225. (1) The Public Defense Services Account is established in the State Treasury, separate  
8 and distinct from the General Fund. The Public Defense Services Account is continuously appropri-  
9 ated to the Public Defense Services Commission for:

10 “(a) Administration and support of the public defense system;

11 “(b) Reimbursement of the State Court Administrator under ORS 151.216 (1)(i); and

12 “(c) Legal representation of parents and children involved in foster care for which matching  
13 funds under 45 C.F.R. 1356.60(c) may be used.

14 “(2) The following moneys shall be deposited in the Public Defense Services Account:

15 “(a) Moneys received by the commission from the State Court Administrator under ORS 151.216  
16 (1)(i);

17 “(b) Moneys received by the Judicial Department under ORS 135.050 (8), 151.487 (1),  
18 419A.211[,], or 419B.198 (1)[, 419C.203 (1) or 419C.535];

19 “(c) Federal matching funds received under 45 C.F.R. 1356.60(c); and

20 “(d) Miscellaneous revenues and receipts of the commission.

21 “(3) All gifts, grants or contributions accepted by the commission under ORS 151.216 shall be  
22 deposited in a separate subaccount created in the Public Defense Services Account to be used by  
23 the commission for the purpose for which the gift, grant or contribution was given or granted.

24 **“SECTION 7b. If Senate Bill 817 becomes law, the amendments to ORS 151.225 by section**  
25 **7a of this 2021 Act become operative on January 1, 2022.”.**
