

House Bill 3032

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Repeals provisions relating to prohibition on employer's ability to exclude applicant from initial interview because of past criminal conviction.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to use of information regarding criminal convictions; repealing ORS 659A.360 and 659A.362.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 659A.360 and 659A.362 are repealed.
