

House Bill 3078

Sponsored by Representative BOSHART DAVIS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits Oregon State Lottery from offering games playable via mobile phone, personal computer or other personal electronic device, except for certain sports betting and multistate numbers drawing lottery games.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to limitations on gambling using personal electronic devices; amending ORS 461.210.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 461.210 is amended to read:

5 461.210. Upon recommendation of the Director of the Oregon State Lottery, the Oregon State
6 Lottery Commission shall adopt rules specifying the types of lottery games to be conducted by the
7 Oregon State Lottery, provided:

8 (1) Each lottery game shall contain security measures that are designed to prevent the re-
9 demption of fraudulent tickets. Every lottery ticket or stub printed after September 29, 1991, shall
10 include a lottery fact which refers to a specific lottery funded project or the benefits and jobs cre-
11 ated for a specific area of economic activity.

12 (2) No name of an elected official shall appear on the tickets of any lottery game.

13 **(3) The Oregon State Lottery may not offer any game that is playable on a mobile phone,
14 personal computer or other personal electronic device, except for:**

15 **(a) Sports betting games that permit betting only before or during a live sporting event;
16 and**

17 **(b) Multistate numbers drawing lottery games that permit betting only before the draw-
18 ing and that were offered in more than 30 states as of January 1, 2019.**
