## House Bill 3163

Sponsored by Representative WITT

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Amends residency requirements for purposes of licenses, tags and permits related to wildlife.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to residency requirements under wildlife statutes; amending ORS 497.002. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: **SECTION 1.** ORS 497.002 is amended to read: 4 497.002. Except as provided in ORS 497.006, as used in this chapter: 5 (1)(a) "Resident" means a person who has physically resided in this state [at least] for not less 6 than six consecutive months immediately prior to the date of making application for a license, tag 7 or permit issued by the State Fish and Wildlife Commission. [Temporary absence from the state for a purpose other than establishing residency outside the state shall not be considered in determining 9 10 whether a person meets the residency requirements of this subsection.] 11 (b) "Resident" does not include a person: 12 (A) Who merely owns real property or pays property taxes in this state; or (B) Who claims resident privileges in another state or country for any purpose. 13 (2) "Nonresident" means any person other than a resident. 14 15
