Prohibits court from allowing public display or public disclosure of images of person in state of nudity, except pursuant to court order entered after showing of good cause.

4	SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "nudity" has the meaning given that term in ORS
5	30.831.
6	(2) A court of this state may not publicly display images of a person in a state of nudity
7	except pursuant to a court order entered after a showing of good cause.
8	(3) Images of a person in a state of nudity that are part of the record in a court pro
9	ceeding shall be subject to inspection only by the parties to the proceedings and their attor
10	neys, and may not be subject to inspection by members of the public except pursuant to a
11	court order entered after a showing of good cause.
