SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Directs State Fish and Wildlife Commission to adopt certain requirements related to carcasses of returning hatchery fish.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of the wildlife laws.
5	SECTION 2. The State Fish and Wildlife Commission shall adopt rules governing the
6	disposition of carcasses of adult hatchery-produced fish returning to hatchery facilities tha
7	include but are not limited to requirements that:
8	(1) At least 45 percent of the carcasses from all adult hatchery-produced fish that return
9	to hatchery facilities, averaged over 10 years, beginning in a year after the rules are adopted
10	must be retained and placed at seasonally appropriate times in natural spawning and rearing
11	areas to enhance nutrient recycling, consistent with pathology constraints; and
12	(2) When selling eggs and carcasses from hatchery facilities to provide revenues to sup
13	port hatchery programs and facilities, the State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall pri
14	oritize sales to, in the following order:
15	(a) Oregon small businesses in communities with high rates of unemployment; and
16	(b) Other Oregon small businesses.
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
