## House Bill 3286

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Allows Department of Land Conservation and Development, Department of State Lands or Department of Transportation to allow bioengineering to protect coastal resources.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to bioengineering for the protection of coastal resources. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Any project approved or undertaken by the Department of Land Conserva-4 tion and Development, Department of State Lands or Department of Transportation for the 5 mitigation, preservation, restoration, remediation or stabilization of coastal resources, in-6 7 cluding shorelands, beaches, dunes, estuarine resources, and infrastrucure and structures 8 built before 1977 or in conformance with statewide land use planning goals related to coastal resources, may use bioengineering practices that incorporate natural materials including trees, plants, logs, rocks and woody debris.
