Prohibits local governments from charging fee to review application for mural and limits grounds for application denial.

2	Relating to murals.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) A local government, as defined in ORS 197.015, may not charge a fee to
5	review an application to install a mural on a building by the building's owner.
6	(2) As used in this section, "mural" means a painting or other artwork affixed to the side
7	of the building that is not for commercial or political campaign purposes.
