## A-Engrossed House Bill 5005

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Criminal Justice Commission for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures by commission from certain lottery moneys.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by commission.

Limits biennial expenditures by commission from federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission; and declaring

3 an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, for the 6 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$72,888,200.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$578,865
is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of
expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Veterans' Services Fund established under
ORS 406.140 to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, for veterans' specialty courts.

11 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 12 \$7,259,068 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for 13 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, 14 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Criminal 15 Justice Commission.

16 <u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 17 \$5,664,770 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for 18 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Criminal Justice 19 Commission.

20 <u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 21 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect 22 July 1, 2021.
