

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5023

13 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Business Devel-**

31 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
32 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment**
33 **of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Business Development**
34 **Department, for the following purposes:**

35 (1) **Business, innovation**

5 **“SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Oregon Busi-**
6 **ness Development Department are not limited for:**

7 **“(1) Loans from the following funds:**

8 **“(a) Oregon Business Development Fund (ORS 285B.092), Oregon Entrepreneurial Devel-**
9 **opment Loan Fund (ORS 285B.758), Credit Enhancement Fund (ORS 285B.215) and Small**
10 **Business Expansion Loan Fund (ORS 285B.133).**

11 **“(b) Special Public Works Fund (ORS 285B.455), Water Fund (ORS 285B.563), Marine**
12 **Navigation Improvement Fund (ORS 777.267), Oregon Port Revolving Fund (ORS 285A.708),**
13 **Safe Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund (ORS 285A.213) and Brownfields Redevelopment**
14 **Fund (ORS 285A.188).**

15 **“(2) Debt service, excluding debt service on lottery revenue bonds and general obligation**
16 **bonds.**

17 **“SECTION 6. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
18 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**
19 **July 1, 2021.”.**
