House Bill 5025

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Parks and Recreation Department for biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department. Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds for certain purposes.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Parks and Recreation Department; and declar-

3 ing an emergency.

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4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the State Parks and Recreation Department, for the 6 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$500,000 for the

7 expenses of the director's office.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 9 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment 10 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-11 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Parks and Recre-12 ation Department, for the following purposes:

- 14 (2) Central services \$ 18,822,587
- 15 (3) Parks development...... \$ 3,422,473
- 16 (4) Direct services...... \$ 67,926,461
- 17 (5) Community support

19 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 20 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment 21 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to 22 the State Parks and Recreation Department, for the following purposes:

23(1) Director's office \$ 1,887,362 Central services \$ 18,528,039 (2) 24 Parks development...... \$ 20,184,465 (3) 25 Direct services...... \$ 59,574,176 (4) 26 27 (5) **Community support** 28 and grants..... \$ 18,901,518
