SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Teacher Standards and Practices Commission for biennial expenses.]

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by commission.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission; and
3 declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
6 **\$14,189,847 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for**
7 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
8 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Teacher Standards**
9 **and Practices Commission for general operations.**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**
12 **July 1, 2021.**
