Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 14 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment 1516 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Veterans' Services Fund established 17 under ORS 406.140 to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, for the following purposes: 18 (1) For services provided 19 by the Department of 20Veterans' Affairs \$ 12,496,892 21**(2)** For payments to counties pursuant to ORS 406.462 \$ 7,474,669 22(3) 23For payments to veterans' 24service organizations pursuant to ORS 406.310 \$ 25497,880 For debt service.....\$ 690,010 26(4) 27"SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 28\$115,372,793 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for 29payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and the Oregon War Veterans' Bond Sinking Account, but excluding lottery funds and fed-30 31 eral funds, collected or received by the Department of Veterans' Affairs for administration, 32grants and services supplied to veterans. "(2) This section does not limit expenditures from the Oregon War Veterans' Bond 33 Sinking Account for purposes described in section 5 of this 2021 Act. 34 35"SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of

- 1 \$1,617,844 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
- 2 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Veterans'
- 3 Affairs.
- 4 "<u>SECTION 5.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Department 5 of Veterans' Affairs for the following purposes are not limited:
- 6 "(1) Debt service;
- 7 "(2) Professional services and related costs associated directly with bond sales;
- 8 **"(3) Loans to veterans; and**
- 9 "(4) Payments on behalf of borrowers for property taxes, city liens, fire insurance, 10 mortgage cancellation insurance and repairs to and miscellaneous charges for borrower-11 owned property that are charged to the loan account and repaid along with the payment of 12 loan interest and principal.
- "SECTION 6. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect
 July 1, 2021.".
