House Joint Memorial 8

SUMMARY

1	JOINT MEMORIAL
2	To the President of the United States and the Senate and the House of Representatives of the United
3	States of America, in Congress assembled:
4	We, your memorialists, the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, in legisla-
5	tive session assembled, respectfully represent as follows:
6	Whereas each year, the western United States faces devastating wildfires that threaten com-
7	munities, livelihoods and the resiliency of our forests; and
8	Whereas wildfires in the United States have destroyed more than 68 million acres in the last
9	decade and more than 10 million acres in 2020 alone; and
10	Whereas prompt replanting and recovery from these disasters is critical to prevent ongoing
11	harm; and
12	Whereas a secure source of seedlings available for replanting will allow us to more quickly re-
13	store our forests, prevent mudslides and preserve habitat for critical species; and
14	Whereas it is imperative that we pair scientific forest management with aggressive reforestation
15	efforts, but there is currently a severe national shortage of seedlings; and
16	Whereas to support reforestation efforts and promote healthy forests, we must drastically in-
17	crease the supply of seedlings across the nation, involving both public and private nurseries; and
18	Whereas a healthy supply of seedlings is also essential in addressing climate change,
19	infrastructure, affordable housing, rural economic development and other pressing needs; and
20	Whereas House Resolution 2562, the Solving Our Shortages for Seedlings Act (SOS for Seedlings
21	Act), addresses the national shortage of seedlings needed for reforestation efforts; and
22	Whereas the SOS for Seedlings Act directs the U.S. Forest Service to develop a national
23	seedling strategy that assesses regional reforestation opportunities and the nursery capacity needed
24	to meet those opportunities; and
25	Whereas the SOS for Seedlings Act provides funding for federal nurseries, which are the main
26	supplier of seedlings for reforestation on federal lands; and
27	Whereas the SOS for Seedlings Act creates a new \$1 billion loan program to address nursery
28	infrastructure and build new state, tribal, local and private nurseries; and
29	Whereas the SOS for Seedlings Act will support wildfire recovery efforts, benefit the environ-
30	ment and restore forests in the State of Oregon and throughout the United States; now, therefore,

Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

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That we, the members of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly, recognize the urgent need to	
address the severe shortage of seedlings needed for reforestation efforts in the State of Oregon and	
throughout the nation; and be it further	
Resolved, That we respectfully urge the Congress of the United States to pass, and the President	
to sign. House Resolution 2562, the Solving Our Shortages for Seedlings Act; and be it further	

Resolved, That a copy of this memorial shall be sent to the President of the United States, to the Senate Majority Leader, to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and to each member of the Oregon Congressional Delegation.

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
