

Senate Bill 230

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes Western Oregon University, Southern Oregon University and Eastern Oregon University to offer professional doctoral degrees.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to degree programs offered by public institutions of higher education; amending ORS
3 352.011 and 352.089.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 352.011 is amended to read:

6 352.011. (1) **As used in this section, "professional doctoral degree" means a first profes-**
7 **sional degree, excluding a Doctor of Philosophy degree, that:**

8 (a) **Represents a category of qualifications in a professional subject area that requires**
9 **students to have previously completed specified undergraduate coursework or obtained pre-**
10 **vious undergraduate degrees before enrolling in the professional doctoral degree granting**
11 **program; and**

12 (b) **Is awarded upon completion of a program that provides the knowledge and skills for**
13 **the recognition, credential or license required for professional practice.**

14 (2) Western Oregon University, Southern Oregon University and Eastern Oregon University are
15 established as comprehensive universities that offer a full range of baccalaureate programs and
16 graduate programs through the master's degree **and the professional doctoral degree.**

17 **SECTION 2.** ORS 352.089 is amended to read:

18 352.089. (1) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall adopt a mission statement for the
19 university, and shall forward the statement to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

20 (2) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall submit any significant change in the
21 university's academic programs to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission. The commission
22 shall establish a process for reviewing the significant program change for approval. The commission
23 shall establish, by rule, what constitutes a significant change to a university's academic program.
24 The commission shall further ensure that approved programs:

25 (a) Are consistent with the mission statement of the university;

26 (b) Do not unnecessarily duplicate academic programs offered by Oregon's other public univer-
27 sities;

28 (c) Are not located in a geographic area that will cause undue hardship to Oregon's other public
29 universities; *[and]*

30 (d) Are allocated among Oregon's public universities to maximize the achievement of statewide

1 needs and requirements; and

2 (e) **Submitted by Western Oregon University, Southern Oregon University or Eastern**
 3 **Oregon University comply with ORS 352.011.**

4 (3)(a) Pursuant to ORS 350.090, on or before September 1 of each even-numbered year, the
 5 Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall submit a consolidated funding request to the
 6 Governor on behalf of all public universities listed in ORS 352.002.

7 (b) The Governor’s budget may include funding requests from public universities.

8 (4) As part of a funding request submitted under subsection (3) of this section, a public univer-
 9 sity listed in ORS 352.002 may request, and appropriations may include but are not limited to,
 10 funding for education and general operations, statewide public services, state-funded debt service,
 11 capital improvements, deferred maintenance, special initiatives and investments or any other pur-
 12 pose authorized by ORS 350.075 (3)(e). Any moneys appropriated to pay debt service for state bonds
 13 must be held by the State Treasurer pursuant to an agreement entered into by the State Treasurer
 14 and a public university under ORS 352.135 (2).

15 (5) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 that wishes to request the issuance of state bonds,
 16 including a public university that elects to remain eligible to receive proceeds of state bonds under
 17 ORS 352.402, must make a request to this effect to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission.
 18 The commission shall establish a process for reviewing the request to issue state bonds. The com-
 19 mission shall decide whether, and in what manner, to make a request for the issuance of state bonds
 20 to the Legislative Assembly.

21 (6)(a) Each public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall respond to a request for data from the
 22 Legislative Assembly or other state body by submitting the requested information to the Higher
 23 Education Coordinating Commission. The commission shall consolidate the data received from public
 24 universities. The commission shall be responsible for providing the data to the Legislative Assembly
 25 or other requesting entity.

26 (b) As used in this subsection, “data” means any information that, as of August 14, 2013, is
 27 collected by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission from each university and reported to
 28 the Legislative Assembly or any other state entity, including but not limited to retention and grad-
 29 uation rates and demographic information on students.

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
