SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Department of Human Services to study and make recommendations to interim committees of Legislative Assembly, no later than September 15, 2022, for legislative changes needed to improve care of residents and training of staff in residential programs.

Sunsets January 2, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to residential programs.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Human Services shall study and evaluate current requirements for residential programs operating in this state. Based on the department's study and evaluation, the department shall develop recommendations, if any, for legislative concepts to improve the care of residents and the training and safety of staff in residential programs.
 - (2) No later than September 15, 2022, the department shall report its recommendations, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to human services.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.
