

Senate Bill 510

Sponsored by Senator THATCHER (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Cancels pension of member of pension program of Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan who is convicted of rape or murder.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to members of the Public Employees Retirement System who commit crimes.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 238A.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) A member of the pension program who is convicted of rape in any degree,**
6 **murder in any degree or aggravated murder forfeits the person's membership in the pension**
7 **program and the Public Employees Retirement Board may not pay a pension to the person.**

8 **(2) Forfeiture of membership under this section does not affect a person's membership**
9 **in the individual account program.**

10 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2021 Act applies to persons who establish membership in**
11 **the pension program of the Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan on or after the effective**
12 **date of this 2021 Act.**
